De differentiatiegraad bij de prostaat, uitgaande van de Gleason-score, is gewijzigd in de TNM 7de editie 2de druk.

G Histopathological Grading

- G1 Well differentiated (slight anaplasia) (Gleason 2 - 6)
G2 Moderately differentiated (moderate anaplasia) (Gleason 7)
G3-4 Poorly differentiated/undifferentiated (marked anaplasia) (Gleason 8 - 10)

These Gleason equivalents differ from those in the first UICC TNM printing.

When either PSA or Gleason is not available, grouping should be determined by T category and whichever of either PSA or Gleason is available. When neither is available Prognostic Grouping is not possible, use Stage Grouping
