














**Figure 6:** Gallbladder and Biliary Tract Cancers: relative survival proportion by sex, Belgium 2017-2021




**Figure 7:** Gallbladder and Biliary Tract Cancers: relative survival proportion by age group in males, Belgium 2017-2021
