Cyto-histopathology register colorectal

Background

The Belgian Cancer Registry (BCR) plays an important supportive role in the organisation and quality evaluation of regional population screening for breast, **colorectal** and cervical cancer.

Belgian pathological anatomy/clinical biology/haematology laboratories are required by law to register the results of breast, cervical and colorectal samples according to specifically established guidelines. This registration relates to the early detection of breast, cervical and colorectal cancer. These data, together with the associated pathology reports, are transferred to BCR in the form of a structured dataset. These data are subsequently treated and registered in the cyto-histopathology (CHP) register.

Content

The database contains all colorectal samples treated and delivered by the Belgian pathological anatomy laboratories.
